2. ARTICLE SUBMISSION

Articles will be accepted from February 1st to April 10th 2018 at the following e-mail address: cidroitparis2018@gmail.com. Papers submitted after the deadline will not be considered.

2.1 Only finished articles will be accepted, preferably in French or in English (papers in Portuguese may also be accepted, exceptionally), with up to 20 pages, including summary and bibliography. The articles submitted are of authors full responsibility.

2.2. Each article submission must contain two files:

- File 1 (to compose the Annals of the event): the article containing author(s) name(s), e-mail(s) and institutional affiliations (word format).
- File 2 (for evaluation): the article without authors any identification (PDF format).

3. NUMBER OF ARTICLES BY AUTHOR

3.1. Each author must send only one article for evaluation, written individually or in co-authorship, and it must indicate for which Working Group it contributes.

3.2. The article can be written by up to two authors. Replacement or modification of the submitted article is not allowed.

4. EVALUATION METHOD

4.1. The evaluation method is the “*Double-blind review*” which does not disclose the author’s name, nor of the evaluators.

4.2 This method requires the examination of the articles by two or more evaluators, which guarantees the equality between the participants and the quality of the approved articles, diminishing subjectivity and ideological preferences.

4.3. Results will be released on **April 24th, 2018.**

5. SELECTION CRITERIA

5.1. Evaluators will assess:

- a) Article’s structure and methodology, conferring the relation between the problem, the objectives and the results.
- b) The respect of the Colloquium central theme and of the chosen Working Group.
- c) Clarity of arguments and subject relevance.
- d) Article’s scientific contribution.
- e) Technical language.

5.2. Authors whose article were selected will be notified by e-mail.

6. ARTICLE'S FORMAL ASPECTS

Articles submitted must contain the following formal aspects:

6.1. Files must be in .doc or .docx format and PDF.

6.2. A **TITLE**. The title should not be written in bold. It should be centered and in upper-case letters. Arial font, size 12.

6.3. An **ABSTRACT**, with a minimum of 100 and a maximum of 250 words. Avoid abbreviations. Arial font, size 10. Single-spacing line.

6.4. At least **3 KEYWORDS**.

6.5. An **ABSTRACT written in a FOREIGN LANGUAGE**, with a minimum of 100 and a maximum of 250 words. Avoid abbreviations. Arial font, size 10. Single-spacing line.

6.5.1. Articles written in **Portuguese** must also include an abstract, keywords and an English title.

6.6. A minimum of **3 KEYWORDS** in a chosen **FOREIGN LANGUAGE**.

6.7. It must be structured as it follows: **INTRODUCTION, DEVELOPMENT, CONCLUSION AND REFERENCES**.

6.8. It must have up to **20 PAGES** (not numbered) in A4 format, vertical position; Arial font, size 12; justified alignment, without syllable separation; 1,5 of spacing line; 1,5cm of paragraph; 3cm for upper and left margin; 2cm for bottom and right margin.

6.9. **QUOTES and REFERENCES** must be presented according to the Chicago rules: http://www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools_citation_guide.html and it must indicate the URLs and DOI of the mentioned texts, when it applies.

6.10. It shouldn't contain **APPENDIX**;

6.11. The file containing the article for evaluation should not make reference to the qualification of its author, under consequence of disqualification.

7. ARTICLE'S PRESENTATION

7.1 Selected articles will be presented by its author(s) during the Working Groups sessions, which will take place simultaneously in different classrooms. It will be led by Professors of the Université Paris 1 - Panthéon-Sorbonne and/or by invited Professors.

7.2 It is mandatory to present registration proof at the entrance and to respect security regulations before entering the University building.

7.3 Only authors can submit papers. In case of co-authorship, the presentation by one of the co-authors is sufficient.

7.4. A participation Certificate will be delivered only to those presenting the article, without exceptions.

7.5. Each author will have 10 minutes to present their article. A signature on the presence list, after the presentation, is a mandatory condition for the delivery of the participation Certificate.

7.6. Discussions might be carried out according to the guidelines given by the coordination table. After presentations, group members are also invited to join the discussions.

7.7. No audiovisual resources (datashow, projectors, etc.) will be available to support the presentations.
